General Rules:

1. Drivers must be 14 years of age or older, those under 18 years of age must have written parental/guardian permission.
2. Drivers must stay on the seat of the tractor at all times. Hands must be on the steering wheel, hand brakes, hand clutch, or throttle at all times during the pull.
3. Excessive consumption of alcoholic beverages will be grounds for disqualification.
4. Farm Stock tractors will be allowed 1 total hook, Classic/Open tractors a total of 2 hooks.
5. Tractor and sled must remain in bounds at all times. Out of bounds will result in disqualification, no measurement will be taken.
6. Wheelie bars are recommended in farm stock, they are required in classic and open. It is recommended that the wheelie bars not be attached to the drawbar in anyway. The wheelie bar pads are to be a minimum of 5" x 5", no more than 10" off the ground and the front edge of the pads must be behind the rear most part of the tire. All bars must support tractor in its heaviest class entered.
7. Weights must not extend rearward beyond rear tires and cannot be more than 11 feet from the center of the rear axle to the farthest point forward.
8. Gas, diesel, or LP fuels only. No alcohol or nitrous oxide fuels may be used in tractors. Gas is allowed a maximum specific gravity of 750. Tractors manufactured to use diesel fuel only cannot be converted to gas or LP. No V-8's allowed.
9. All rules will be interpreted by the Pull Committee. Any unforeseen problems or oversights will be ruled upon by the Pull Committee with their rulings being final.

Farm Stock: 1959 and older

1. Tire size: All classes: max 15.5X38; any rim width allowed in all classes. No cut or altered tires will be allowed.
2. Rpm's will be determined by the Nebraska test chart. Any tractor not listed will use manufacturer's data, a 10% margin for error will be allowed. All tractors to have positive throttle stops.
3. Any gear, speed limit is 3 mph to be checked by radar. One beep after speed cone will result in disqualification.
4. Drawbar height must not exceed 18" or be less than 18" from center of axle to hooking point.

Classic: 1959 and older

1. Tire size: All classes: max 18.4X38; any rim width. Cut tires allowed.
2. Rpm's will be determined by the Nebraska test chart. Any tractor not listed will use manufacturer's data, a 10% margin for error will be allowed. All tractors to have positive throttle stops.
3. Safety: Classic tractors must have a working kill switch.
4. Any gear, speed limit is 4 mph to be checked by radar. One beep after speed cone will result in disqualification.
5. Drawbar height must not exceed 20" or be less than 18" from center of axle to hooking point.

Open: 1959 and older

1. Tire size: All classes: max 18.4X38; any rim width. Cut tires allowed
2. Rpm's will be determined by the Nebraska test chart. Any tractor not listed will use manufacturer's data, a 30% margin for error will be allowed. All tractors to have positive throttle stops.
3. Any gear, any speed.
4. Safety: Open tractors must have a working kill switch. All open tractors will have a 3/8 inch steel plate over flywheel and clutch housing or a scatter safety blanket may be used.
5. Drawbar height must not exceed 20" or be less than 18" from center of axle to hooking point.
6. No billet heads or diesel converted to gas heads will be allowed.
